Correction by Les Producteurs de lait du Québec to the text entitled “Le lait renversé d’Alain Bourbeau” (Alain Bourbeau’s Spilt Milk) by Vincent Geloso, which was published on the Journal de Montréal’s Web site on September 7, 2016.

Vincent Geloso is mistaken in his text “Le lait renversé d’Alain Bourbeau”

Contrary to the statements made by Vincent Geloso of the Montreal Economic Institute in his text "Le lait renversé d’Alain Bourbeau," published on September 7, 2016 on the Journal de Montréal's site, there are no customs tariffs that apply to beef, pork and wheat imported into Canada from the United States. As shown in the list of Canadian custom tariffs in chapters 1, 2, 10 and 11, NAFTA signatories, among others, are excluded from custom tariffs on beef, pork and wheat. Therefore, American beef, pork and wheat enter Canada completely duty-free. Mr. Bourbeau’s statement that “pork, beef and wheat, which are priced based on North American market prices and are freely traded between the two countries" (Canada and the United States) is therefore accurate.
